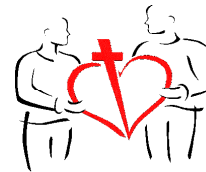

Why Deuteronomy?

I started the Read the Bible in 88 days Program again. I am at a tough spot in the reading right now. How do you tell yourself when reading a book like Deuteronomy, “This is somehow important, I hope I can finish it!”? How do you balance the mundane nature of Deuteronomy and realize, “I am so glad I don’t have to do all that!”?

Those are loaded questions of course! Deuteronomy is rich and fulfilling, even positive and challenging in a lot of places. One thing I couldn't help but notice is the number of times certain words are used to get Israel to realize how important it is to have God be a part of them as individuals and as a community.

Remember, Don't Forget-20 times, Fear (Awe)-14, Keep, Obey, Follow-78, Love-20, Rejoice-8

These, of course, are a small portion of the words in this rich book. Doesn't sound very much like OT Law does it? “Deuteronomy recognizes the need for God to act within the heart **IF** Israel is to achieve faithful obedience to God's covenant.” Are we as the Church, as God's Chosen, allowing God to act within our hearts? Only **IF** we choose to be obedient and faithful to Him and Him alone. Only **IF** we choose to LOVE God above all else!!

Because of the great usage of the internet - it just seems that we would be actively involved in spreading the gospel through this medium. So, how do we do spread the message of Jesus online? A good place to start is the church website. Are we using it to its potential? Does the community know it is available? If I were a stranger and pulled up the website, would it create an interest in the body here? These are just some questions I think we should consider. Look at these facts:

To reach 50 million users it took:

Radio - 38 years

Television - 13 years

Internet - 4 years

IPOD - 3 years

Facebook added 100 million users in less than 9 months

IPOD Application downloads hit 1 Billion in 9 months.

Maybe, just maybe we need to do a mission trip.....online. What would this look like? How would it happen? Something to think about.....wanna try?
