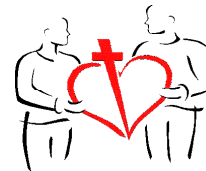

S.H.A.R.E. Discussion Questions

Text: 2 Corinthians 3:18

1. **OPEN:** When did you last experience the “light bulb” effect— suddenly understanding something that once confused you?
2. **DIG: a)** At the beginning of the sanctification process, God replaces our stone hearts with hearts of flesh. (Ezekiel 36:26-27) What do you think it means to have a heart of flesh, as opposed to one of stone? **b)** Why can't the Holy Spirit make any progress with a stone-hearted person?
3. **DIG: a)** How does beholding the glory of Christ in the gospel help to transform us? **b)** In practical terms, how do we go about beholding Christ's glory in the gospel?
4. **REFLECT: a)** The Holy Spirit's goal is to make us like Christ. You could choose virtually any story in the Gospels that portrays Christ and say to yourself, “God wants to make me like this.” For example, read Mark 1:40-42. What does this passage tell you about what the Spirit intends you to become? **b)** How do you feel when you consider that this is part of God's agenda for you? Intimidated? Excited? Skeptical? Confident? Explain.
5. **PRAYER:** Close in prayer by reflecting on the transformation process you are experiencing. Tell God what you still struggle with and thank Him for exposing the area and defeating sin and death on the cross.

Three lessons for Christ followers. 1. Remember you will be held to the standard that you put on others. 2. Jesus says to worry about what you are doing, not others. 3. We will never agree on everything, however we must always be unified. That's what happens when Jesus is our focus. Get into the game or yell from the sidelines, you must choose. It is easier to focus on others when you are not involved in ministry. Epignosis.
